The aim of the course is to enable delegates to become familiar with the **principles of bariatric surgery**, and the operative anatomy and techniques for **laparoscopic gastric banding, sleeve gastrectomy and gastric bypass**.

The course will include:

- **Expert faculty** of experienced Bariatric surgeons
- **Live expert demonstration** of Bariatric surgery
- Advice and guidance for **patient/procedure selection, risk management** and discussion on the **different techniques** employed
- Simulated suturing practice
