Laparoscopic Training Bursaries 2012

The ALS is awarding eight generously funded Stryker Laparoscopic Training Bursaries for a value of approximately £1,000 to be awarded in February 2012. The purpose of these awards is to enable specialist registrars to extend their training in minimal access surgery by attending either the Core or Intermediate Skills in Laparoscopic Surgery Courses, held at The Royal College of Surgeons of England in the prestigious Raven Department of Education. Please note the award does not cover travel or accommodation expenses.

In order to be considered for one of the eight Stryker Training Bursaries, candidates should initially email jtreglohan@asgbi.org.uk to request an application form. The completed form must be returned to Mr Mark Vipond, Honorary Secretary of the Association of Laparoscopic Surgeons, at The Royal College of Surgeons of England, 35-43 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3PE detailing why the Stryker Training Bursary would be beneficial.
