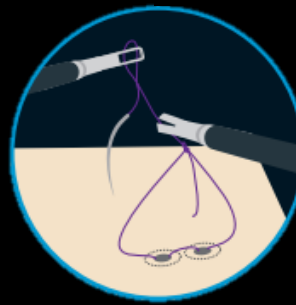
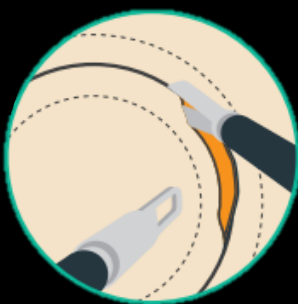
Task 2 TYING EXTRACORPOREAL BORDER KNOTS AND PLACING THEM TO SIMULATE APPENDICETOMY
