*** After the course participants will be provided with a box trainer and training kit at home for 4 weeks practice with one session weekly of remote trainer feedback during live training (North-West and Mersey Deanery only) On achieving LAPPASS competency (confirmed by trainer) the examination and certification will be arrange in Wigan (trainees must hold ALSGBI membership to sit the examination and receive certificate)(5 weeks later).**

The course will be run under strict social distancing rules with training area arranged in cubicles style.

Tea and lunch will not be provided in order to observe distancing rules. (The participants will make own arrangements, dining area available on site).

The course is free of charge for North-West deanery trainees with a £90 deposit refundable on return of the training kit.

The course fees for other trainees is £100. Members of the ALSGBI receive 20% discount.
