Aim of the course:

This course is designed as a hands-on training for higher colorectal surgical trainee and consultants that want to set up a transanal practice.

It addresses a gap in surgical training in the United Kingdom in what is an emerging branch of colorectal practice.

The aim of this course is to introduce the attendee to trans-anal surgery, with a balanced mixture of lectures, case-based discussion and hands-on training on the two most commonly used TES platforms (TAMIS & TEO).

Learning outcomes:

On completion of the course, participants will:

- Describe the different characteristics and limitations of the TAMIS & TEO platforms

- Identify patients balancing indications and contraindications
- Demonstrate the basic technical steps, ergonomics and TES suturing
- Demonstrate the set-up of the TAMIS & TEO platforms
- Outline the most common pitfall and technical problem and how to overcome them
- Describe the indications for neoadjuvant and adjuvant treatment of early rectal cancer

Venue of the course:

The course will be held at the Medical Education Centre on the fifth floor admin block, which is accessible via the lift on the right upon entering the main entrance at the York Hospital, Wigginton Rd, Clifton, York, YO31 8HE.

Parking at York Hospital:
