

The NORTH General Surgery FRCS Mock VIVA Course

Overview

This intensive two-day course is designed as a revision tool for candidates preparing for the FRCS General Surgery Part 2 examination. It is held 3 times per year, strategically timed ahead of FRCS exam dates.

Venue & Sponsorship

- Location: Depuy International Centre, St Anthony's Road, Leeds, LS11 8DT
- Duration: Two full days (08:00-17:00).
- Used to be one day course, but now changed to two full days beginning from Jan
- Sponsor: Partially supported by **Ethicon**.
- Breakfast, refreshments and lunch are provided during the course.

Faculty

- Experienced consultants from various surgical subspecialties and institutions across the UK.
- All faculty members have extensive clinical experience and familiarity with the FRCS examination format.

Course Structure

The course closely mimics the FRCS viva exam format, providing:

- Mock viva circuits, each with 3-4 clinical scenarios.
- Each scenario lasts 5 minutes, followed by 5 minutes of structured feedback.
- Candidates receive scores and detailed feedback per scenario.
- Candidates will have the opportunity to move through all viva stations
- Additional feedback sessions are available upon request.
- Depends on time allocations; candidates may do multiple turns on same day

Course Components

The day begins with an academic teaching session:



• "How to Critique a Research Paper" and tips for the Academic Station (08:00–08:45)

Following this, candidates rotate through viva stations in small groups. Stations include:

- 1. Upper GI / HPB Surgery
- 2. Colorectal Surgery
- 3. Trauma & Emergency Surgery
- 4. Critical Care
- 5. General Surgery & Principles of Surgery
- 6. Academic Viva & Basic Sciences
- 7. Breast Surgery

Each station is led by one or two examiners.
