

Travel Information to Radisson Blu Hotel, Stansted



Located less than a five-minute walk from Stansted airport's main terminal, the hotel is reached using a series of conveniently sheltered walkways.

The Radisson Blu is also well placed for the Stansted Express rail service and bus stations.

Driving

Stansted Airport is just off the M11 motorway.

- If coming from London, use Junction 8a of the M11.
- If approaching from the Cambridge direction, use Junction 8 of the M11.
- The postcode for Stansted Airport is **CM24 1RW**.

Estimated times and distance

- From Central London to Stansted by car is about 40 miles / ~65 km (depending exactly where in London) and can take about 1 hour by car in good traffic. (Times may vary depending on traffic, time of day, etc.).

Parking, rentals etc.

- There are **official airport parking** options; pre booking can save money and ensure availability. Stansted Airport.
- **Car rental services** are available at the Car Rental Village at the airport.

Taxis/Drop-off

- A **taxi** is available 24/7 via an official provider; there are pick up / drop off areas.
- To book a taxi in advance call **01279 661 111**.

By Train

Main train service: Stansted Express

- Operates between London Liverpool Street and Stansted Airport.
- Journey time: about **48 minutes** between Liverpool Street → Stansted.
- Frequency: **every 15 minutes** during daytime.
- The station is just **2 minutes' walk** from the main terminal.

Other train options and connections

- Some services (Greater Anglia etc.) connect Stansted to destinations such as Cambridge, Peterborough, Leicester, Birmingham.
- To use London Underground (Tube) connections: from Liverpool Street you can connect to Central, Circle, Elizabeth, Hammersmith & City and Metropolitan lines. From Tottenham Hale (a stop on Stansted Express) you can access the Victoria Line.

Timings

- First train from Liverpool Street to Stansted: ~ **03:40** on some days; last about **23:25**.
- First train from Stansted back to London: ~ **05:30**. Last train from airport ~ **00:30**.

By Air

- **Stansted** is one of the major London airports and has many international and domestic airlines flying into it. Common carriers include low cost airlines (e.g. Ryanair) and others serving European destinations.
- Once you land at Stansted, you'll use the terminal's arrival halls, then follow signs through customs / baggage, and exit into the transit / ground transport area. The train station is directly beneath / adjacent to terminals, making onward connections easier by train or road.
